## Information Bulletin



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On March 29<sup>th</sup>, at WAG headquarter, a LOC Air Sport Commission Meeting has been held, with the purpose to harmonize the information available to each Air Sport with respect to the Test Event and to plan further steps of the Organizing Committee.



In Mondovì, the WAG Project Manager Franco Gambino and a Representative of the City of Turin Gianni Ventura met City of Mondovì Major to define further collaboration for the World Air Games of Turin.



Mr. Bruno Rambaudi, WAG President, and Mr. Giorgio Milanesi WAG General Director, took part in a meeting with RAI, in Rome, on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, to discuss future collaboration for World Air Games Broadcasting.



A dedicated Aeromodelling Commission Meeting, on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, was held to plan next Test Event scheduled on June 7-8<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at the Aeroporto Torino-Aeritalia for the outdoor competitions and at the Palaruffini for the indoor competitions.



On April 4<sup>th</sup> at 14.30 at the “Assessorato allo Sport” of Turin Municipality, a presentation of the World Air Games Torino 2009 Communication Plan has been given.



A Paragliding and Hang-glidering Commission Meeting (April 4<sup>th</sup>) has been carried out to plan next Test Event scheduled on August 18-19<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at Avigliana Site.
